4th Sunday of Easter

Dear brothers and sisters, today's Word of God gives us the contrasting views of two types of shepherds. True shepherds and false shepherds. A true shepherd always gives his all for his flock. False shepherds only care about themselves. A true shepherd sacrifices himself for his flock. The false shepherd only comes to shear the sheep. True shepherds always look for fountain of water and green pastures to feed their flocks. False shepherds only seek happiness for themselves. They live for pleasure, are lazy and irresponsible for the survival of their flock. Jesus gave the model of the good shepherd, who is God himself. He has not found comfort for himself. He travels through the wind and dust to find each lost sheep and bring them back to the fold. For the life of the sheep, He is willing to deal with evil to protect the sheep. He accepted death so that the sheep could live.

That is also an example for each of us. Each of us is God's shepherd as we have the responsibility to care for and protect our brothers and sisters. Each of us must be responsible for the safety of our fellow human beings. Each of us has a duty to repel the evil that is raging in our living environment. No one is allowed to be indifferent to the evil that surrounds their family and village. No one is allowed to be irresponsible towards the full and hungry meals of their parents, children or neighbors. If each of us knows how to live responsibly towards our brothers and sisters, this life will have fewer contradictions and fewer tears of sadness and resentment. If each of us knows how to shoulder our brothers' burdens, and know how to use our shoulders as a fulcrum to support our brothers and sisters, then this life will be a paradise where people are enjoying the sweetest moments of life, happiness and love.
