XV Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus expanded his mission by sending his disciples out to preach the Gospel. Jesus chose them to send them out to preach. They proclaim the Gospel of Jesus and urge people to change their lives so they can receive the Kingdom of God that is coming through Jesus.

Jesus did not teach them to preach with vast sermons or with strong, wise, and knowledgeable arguments to convince everyone, but God told them to preach with testimonies, that is, with witness of live, their very lives. As for the things they have to say and preach, in short there are only two or three things: wishing peace—announcing that the Kingdom of Heaven is near—and urging people to repent. That means God wants His disciples to say less and do more. Of course, God does not forbid them to tell everyone all the teachings they have heard.

For us today, God also calls and sends us to preach the Kingdom of God. Because each of us has received the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, we are called and sent to preach: Some by words, but all by deeds, that is, by life, by good exemplary action. That means we all must be witnesses of God and the Kingdom of Heaven, no one is exempt, even a paralyzed patient lying in bed.

Chúa Nhật XV Thường Niên B

Chúa Giêsu mở rộng hoạt động của Người bằng cách sai các môn đệ ra đi rao giảng Tin Mừng. Chúa Giêsu đã tuyển chon để sai đi rao giảng. Ho loan báo Tin Mừng của Chúa Giêsu và thúc giuc người ta hoán cải cuộc sống, để có thể đón nhận Nước Thiên Chúa đang đến qua con người của Chúa Giêsu.

Chúa không dạy các ông phải rao giảng bằng những bài giảng thuyết tràng giang đại hải hay bằng những lý luận đanh thép, khôn ngoan, thông thái nhằm thuyết phục mọi người, nhưng Chúa bảo các ông phải giảng bằng chứng tích, tức là bằng chính đời sống của họ. Còn những điều các ông phải nói, phải giảng, tóm lai vỏn ven có hai hay ba điều: chúc bình an – báo tin Nước Trời đã đến hay đã gần và thúc giuc người ta ăn năn hối cải. Nghĩa là Chúa muôn các môn đệ của Chúa nói ít và làm nhiều, dĩ nhiên Chúa không cầm họ kế lại cho mọi người tất cả những giáo huấn mà ho đã được nghe.

Đối với chúng ta hôm nay, Chúa cũng kêu gọi và sai chúng ta đi truyền giảng Nước Thiên Chúa. Bởi vì mỗi người chúng ta khi đã lãnh bí tích Rửa tôi và Thêm sức, chúng ta đều được kêu gọi và sai đi rao giảng: Có người bằng lời nói, nhưng tất cả đều bằng việc làm, tức là bằng đời sống, bằng hành động gương mẫu tốt lành. Nghĩa là tất cả chúng ta đều phải là chứng nhân của Chúa và của Nước Trời, không ai được chuẩn chước, cho dù là một bệnh nhân bất toai nằm trên giường cũng thể.
