Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel passage, we see that Jesus had to confront the unbelief of his own countrymen. They thought they knew Him too well when they could say who He was, what He did, and who were His relatives. They returned to what they had grasped and then turned away from the call of immediate reality. They separate themselves from the Kingdom of Heaven that is coming to them. The Gospel also records: seeing their unbelief, Jesus did not perform any miracles, meaning that He did not show them the power of the Kingdom of Heaven and He went to preach in the surrounding villages.

The attitude of the villagers of Nazareth can also be a temptation for Christians today. We can be proud and complacent with our teachings and understanding of religion, then turn away from God's invitation in the events that are happening around us. In other words, our religious life today cannot be framed within some available knowledge about God and salvation, nor within some pre-determined rituals. On the contrary, it must be carried out, manifests through listening and searching for God's intentions in history, in the heart of individual lives and in the activities of the social community. The problem is whether we can really get rid of our existing prejudices, concepts, and views to truly listen to God's new voice through events of today's reality.

Qua bài Tin Mừng hôm nay chúng ta thấy Chúa Giêsu, Ngài đã phải đụng đầu với sự cứng lòng tin của chính những kẻ đồng hương với Ngài. Họ tưởng rằng họ đã biết quá rõ về Ngài khi nói ra được Ngài là con ai, đã làm gì và ai là những người thân thích với Ngài. Họ đã trở về với những cái họ đã nắm được để rồi quay lưng trước lời kêu gọi của thực tế trước mắt. Họ tự tách mình ra khỏi Nước Trời đang đến với họ. Phúc Âm còn ghi lại: thấy họ cứng lòng tin, Chúa Giêsu đã không làm một phép lạ nào, nghĩa là Ngài đã không tỏ quyền năng của Nước Trời cho họ và Ngài đi rao giảng ở những làng xung quanh.

Thái độ của dân làng Nadarét cũng có thể là cơn cám dỗ của người Kitô hữu hôm nay. Chúng ta có thể tự hào và tự mãn với những bài giáo lý, những hiểu biết về đạo, để rồi quay lung trước lời mời gọi của Chúa trong những sự kiện, những biến cố đang xảy ra chung quanh chúng ta. Nói cách khác, việc sống đạo của chúng ta hôm nay không thể đóng khung trong một số kiến thức có sẵn về Thiên Chúa, về ơn cứu độ, cũng như trong một số nghi lễ đã được quy định sẵn, trái lại phải được thể hiện qua việc lắng nghe, tìm kiếm ý định của Chúa trong lịch sử, trong chính lòng cuộc đời cá nhân và trong sinh hoạt của cộng đồng xã hội. Vấn đề là chúng ta có thực sự thoát ra được những thành kiến, những quan niệm, những lối nhìn sẵn có để thực sự lắng nghe tiêng nói mới mẻ của Chúa qua các biến cố, qua các sự kiện của thực tế hôm nay.
